What is a Demolition Plant Operator?

This Apprenticeship has been designed in close consultation with the Demolition Industry and sets out to offer Demolition Plant Operatives an appreciation of all aspects of demolition

Demolition Plant Operatives are trained to demolish or dismantle buildings and other structures. Once the demolition is complete, the site needs to be cleared and the debris moved, often for recycling.
